DEZAMĂGIRI ȘI TENSIUNI. DIN ISTORICUL RELAȚIILOR ROMÂNO-AMERICANE ÎN PRIMUL RĂZBOI MONDIAL ȘI LA CONFERINȚA PĂCII

Abstract: As many European countries did, during World War I Romanian hopes were directed towards the United States in search of economic support, political guarantees and confirmation for its national aspirations. But sometimes these hopes were naive and the uncompromising attitude of Ion I. C. Brătianu generated a series of diplomatic tensions that could have been fatal for the Romanian national goal. At the same time, the new political and diplomatic vision of President Wilson was incompatible with some of the Romanian claims.
